Not Included in the Daily Rate

- International and domestic flights and visas (Visa cost approximately USD 10 each);
 - Accommodation before and after the contracted safari period, including delays caused by lost or delayed luggage;
 - Dipping, packing, shipping, and taxidermy services;
 - Dip and pack services are handled by Lifeforms Taxidermy (POR);
 - Firearm import permits – USD 250 per firearm.
 - Please note: Blaser rifles and other take down firearms will have additional barrels classified as separate firearms and charged at USD 250 per barrel;*
 - Hunter's license – USD 350 per hunter per concession, or USD 600 for a multiple-area license (must be applied for prior to safari);
 - Weapon rental – USD 50 per firearm per day; ammunition at USD 20 per round.
- Charged for the full safari duration, not only days used:
- Pre-baiting for cats – USD 450 per day (excluding bait costs);
 - Charter flights by light aircraft – approximately USD 1,800–2,000 per hour depending on aircraft size.
 - Charters must be booked at least two months in advance and prepaid by transfer;*
 - Airport pickup and road transport to camp – USD 800 per vehicle, and USD 800 return transfer upon completion of the safari (where possible);
 - Niassa Community Conservation Fee – USD 100 per person per day (Niassa hunts only);
 - Use of satellite telephone;
 - Gratuities;
 - Medical, evacuation, trophy, and personal insurance.

INFORMATION | SPECIAL CONDITIONS | BOOKING TERMS

- Please note: Elephant trophies from Mozambique cannot currently be exported to the USA or EU. Export is permitted to Mexico, Canada, South America, and Russia. Regulations may change and should be confirmed prior to booking;
 - Minimum safari durations:
 - Elephant: 14 days
 - Lion: 18 days
 - Leopard: 14 days
 - Buffalo, sable, hippo, or crocodile: 10 days
 - Plains game may be added to any of these above mentioned safaris at trophy fee cost only;
 - Cat safaris: bait animals are charged at 100% of the trophy fee and are fully exportable;
 - Hunter's licenses and firearm permits must be paid with the deposit and are non-refundable in the event of cancellation;
 - CITES permits: clients must apply for import permits after the safari;
 - Upon booking, clients must provide:
 - Two passport photographs;
 - Copy of passport:
 - Firearm make, model, and serial number (accuracy is essential to avoid serious delays);
 - Number of bullets to be imported (maximum 100 rounds per firearm).

- Prior to arrival, clients must confirm which clearing agent and taxidermist will handle their trophies;
 - Clients are strongly advised to obtain comprehensive travel insurance. JWK Safaris (Pty) Ltd, JWK Safaris LLC, and their partners cannot be held responsible for lost hunting time due to airline delays or lost luggage;
 - All safaris must be booked and paid at least six (6) months in advance:
 - Cancellation within six months: deposit forfeited;
 - Cancellation six months or more prior: deposit held for a future safari at applicable new rates;
 - Should JWK Safaris (Pty) Ltd, JWK Safaris LLC, or their partners cancel a safari for any reason, all deposits will be fully refunded;
 - A deposit of 50% of daily rates is required to secure a booking, with the balance payable no later than 180 days prior to the hunt;
 - Trophy fees are payable in USD cash at the end of the safari or held in escrow with the appointed agent;
 - Safari season in Mozambique runs from 1 April to 30 November;
 - No traveller's cheques or VISA cards are accepted;
 - All balances must be paid in USD cash only.

Sable Camp – Niassa Block L2

Sable Camp is beautifully positioned on the pristine **Lugenda River** in northern Mozambique, along the south-western boundary of the world-renowned **Niassa Game Reserve**. This exceptional wilderness area offers outstanding densities of **lion, leopard, buffalo, sable, and plains game**, with abundant **hippo and crocodile** inhabiting the Lugenda River system.

The concession encompasses **over 350,000 hectares** of untouched African wilderness, providing a truly authentic and remote safari experience that epitomises classic East African big-game hunting.

Mbamba Camp – Niassa Block R4

Mbamba Camp is centrally located within **Block R4**, set against the dramatic backdrop of the **Mbamba Mountain Range**. Situated in the heart of the Niassa Game Reserve, this concession is considered the **crown jewel of the JWK Safaris portfolio**.

With excellent populations of all key species, this vast block spans nearly **370,000 hectares** and delivers some of the most consistent and high-quality hunting available anywhere in Niassa.

Location

Niassa Province, Mozambique

- Approximately **1½–2 hours** by charter flight from **Nampula or Pemba** directly into camp
- Due to the extreme remoteness, **no road access** is possible
- Clients typically travel via **Johannesburg to Pemba** on **Airlink**, followed by a private charter flight directly to camp.

The prime hunting season in this region runs from **July through November**, offering excellent conditions for all species.

Camp Experience

The Niassa Camps operated by **JWK Safaris partners** are designed in classic **East African luxury safari style**. Guests are accommodated in spacious, well-appointed safari tents featuring:

- On-suite bathrooms
- Hot water
- Complete bedding
- Mosquito nets
- Daily laundry and housekeeping services
- **WiFi available in camp**

Comfort, privacy, and immersion in the wilderness are central to the JWK Safaris camp philosophy.

Game & Hunting

This concession boasts exceptional densities of **lion, leopard, buffalo, sable, and plains game**.

Thanks to long-term, responsible wildlife management, **lion hunted in this area are eligible for export to the European Union**, subject to regulations.

- **Strict minimum age requirement of 6 years** applies to all lions
- The total hunting area exceeds **450,000 hectares**
- **Lion, leopard, and hyena** may be hunted at night, where permitted by regulation

This is one of the most remote and wild concessions offered by JWK Safaris.

Environment & Climate

- **Elevation:** 1,200–1,400 feet
- **Temperatures:**
 - Coldest nights/early mornings: approx. **40°F (5°C)**
 - Warmest daytime temperatures: approx. **100°F (37°C)**

Due to higher elevation, temperatures are generally more moderate than coastal areas.

- **Rainfall:** Primarily December to March, with occasional showers year-round
- **Malaria:** Prophylaxis is required

A Typical Day on Safari

Days begin before first light with tea or coffee and a light breakfast before departing camp at dawn. Hunting starts immediately and is conducted primarily by **spot-and-stalk** or **walk-and-stalk**, depending on the species.

A packed lunch is usually enjoyed in the field, with a return to camp in the late afternoon or evening. Typical shooting distances range from **50–200 metres**, rarely exceeding this.

This is, without question, **JWK Safaris' most remote and untamed concession**. For those seeking Africa as it once was—wild, vast, and uncompromising—**Niassa delivers an experience like no other.**
